This course will provide professionals working in or related to the oil and gas sector with a comprehensive understanding of the technical and commercial fundamentals of the industry.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND THIS COURSE

This course is intended for personnel from all sectors connected to the oil and gas industry — including government agencies, regulatory authorities, operators, contractors, and service companies (such as legal and tax advisors, insurance firms, banks, etc.). It is especially valuable for both seasoned professionals and newcomers to the industry, as well as for technical and non-technical staff working in areas such as HR, finance, IT, procurement, administration, environment, engineering, and drilling, who would benefit from a broader understanding of the “big picture.”

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Gain knowledge and understanding of the processes involved in oil and gas exploration, reservoir analysis, drilling, extraction, transportation, crude and gas processing, liquefied natural gas (LNG), refining, and product sales.
- Understand the legal and commercial structures from drilling and production.
- Acquire knowledge of the roles of regulators, National and International Oil and Gas Companies.
- Gain both technical and commercial insights into the industry.
- Understand the industry’s terminology and language.

- Participants will be provided with specially designed materials that reference the oil and gas sector of Equatorial Guinea, neighboring countries, and the global market.
